

## **Pathway Transfer in Training**

## 1. Purpose

1.1. To document the College process for transfer of registrars on the ACRRM Fellowship program between Fellowship training pathways.

## 2. Application and scope

- 2.1. This process applies to registrars who are currently undertaking the ACRRM Fellowship program and who seek to transfer between any of the ACRRM Fellowship pathways:
  - 2.1.1. Australian General Practice Training (AGPT)
  - 2.1.2. Rural Generalist Training Scheme (RGTS)
  - 2.1.3. Independent Pathway (IP)
  - 2.1.4. Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS)

## 3. Process

- 3.1. The registrar:
  - 3.1.1. completes and submits an application form to the College (Pathway Transfer Application)
  - 3.1.2. accepts offer (when issued by College)
- 3.2. The College:
  - 3.2.1. reviews application and other information already held by the College. In particular, the following will be reviewed:
    - 3.2.1.1. eligibility
    - 3.2.1.2. training commencement date
    - 3.2.1.3. training period completed
    - 3.2.1.4. current leave status
    - 3.2.1.5. funding accessed if currently on a funded pathway
    - 3.2.1.6. progression through Fellowship requirements including any assessment outcomes
    - 3.2.1.7. financial status (i.e. no outstanding fees)
  - 3.2.2. requests additional information from the registrar if required
  - 3.2.3. requests additional information from other organisations (e.g. RVTS) if applicable.
  - 3.2.4. advises applicant in writing, one of the following:
    - 3.2.4.1. transfer approved
    - 3.2.4.2. transfer not approved
