Position Criteria – Selection Interviewer (ACRRM Representative)

To be eligible to apply for the ACRRM Representative role, the following criteria is to be met:

- To be a Fellow of ACRRM
- Hold minimum five years' experience working in a rural or remote setting
- Demonstrated understanding of ACRRM's vision and mission, training program requirement and the selection process
- Recognition of, and ability to describe, the health service needs of a diverse range of patients across the rural or remote regions, cultures and/or backgrounds
- Knowledge of and/or experience in behavioural interview process e.g. Objective Structured Clinical Examinations (OSCEs) or Multiple Mini Interviews (MMI).
- Ability to contribute to a team-based selection process
- Good understanding of the evidence and criteria required to determine the applicant's suitability to undertake ACRRM training

Desirable:

- Experience in providing registrar training supervision in a general practice setting and/or experience working as a medical educator
- Understanding of the role of the Regional Training Organisation in the AGPT Program and knowledge related to local education and training delivery

Timeframe:
