

Transition to College-Led Training Advisory Committee

Communique – 24 August 2021

The tenth meeting of the Australian Government Department of Health Transition to College-Led Training Advisory Committee (TCLTAC) was held on 24 August 2021.

Members endorsed the Terms of Reference for a new Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander General Practice Training Advisory Group (Advisory Group), which will be co-chaired by Ms Monica Barolits-McCabe, CEO, Australian Indigenous Doctors Association, and Professor Ruth Stewart, National Rural Health Commissioner.

The Advisory Group will consider the future arrangements for providing Salary Support within Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Services and for supporting increased training opportunities for registrars interested in working in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health settings. The Advisory Group will be convened for approximately two half-day workshops.

The Committee also heard updates from the Department, the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners and the Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine.
