

Transition to College-Led Training Advisory Committee

Communique – 7 June 2022

The 17th meeting of the Australian Government Department of Health Transition to College-Led Training Advisory Committee (TCLTAC) was held face to face in Melbourne and virtually on 7 June 2022.

The Department provided an update on progress of the transition of the Australian General Practice Training (AGPT) program to a college-led model. The Department is continuing to work closely with the colleges to negotiate terms of the college-led grant agreements.

Members were provided with an update on the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander General Practice Training Advisory Group (the Advisory Group). This included discussions regarding the Aboriginal Health Training (Strategic Plans) funding and proposed plans for a governance group to provide advice regarding the Salary Support program and Aboriginal Health Training funds. Discussion among members included representation of the governance group. The terms of reference for the new governance group will be presented for endorsement at the TCLTAC meeting in July.

Members also discussed the transition of AGPT training data database migration from the Registrar Information Data Exchange (RIDE) to the Health Data Portal. The colleges will participate in user acceptance testing through the transfer of GP training data to the Health Data Portal. Members noted the data privacy provisions and data security of training data held in the Department's Health Data Portal.

TCLTAC will next meet on 12 July 2022.
